What will this cost?

The proposed renovations would cost \$6.483 million dollars and would be funded with Recovery Zone Economic Development Bonds or similar bonds. The Library does not have sufficient revenue to repay these bonds. A tax increase of 4 to 6 cents per \$100 in assessed value would be required. This represents a \$12 increase to the owner of a \$100,000 home. To calculate the tax increase to an individual homeowner, multiply the current tax bill by .0073.
